Broward County is pleased to announce **Quantities, Inc.** has renewed its certification as a **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise [DBE]** in Florida, under a **Unified Certification Program [UCP]** in accordance with 49 CFR, PART 26.

DBE certification continues from your anniversary date, but is contingent upon Quantities, Inc. renewing its eligibility annually through this office, the Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD). OESBD will notify you in advance of your obligation to provide continuing eligibility documents; however, assuring continued certification is your responsibility. Failure to continue your eligibility will result in immediate action to decertify Quantities, Inc. as a DBE.

As long as Quantities, Inc. is listed in the DBE Directory, it is considered DBE Certified by all Florida UCP Members.

DBE Certification is subject to actions by governmental agencies impacting the disadvantaged status of Quantities, Inc.

Quantities, Inc. will be listed in Florida's **UCP DBE Directory** which can be accessed via the internet, at

DBE certification is **NOT** a guarantee of work, but enables Quantities, Inc. to compete for, and perform, contract work on all USDOT Federal Aid (FAA, FTA and FHWA) projects in Florida as a DBE contractor, sub-contractor, consultant, and sub-consultant or material supplier.
